

## **Chili Cook Off**

**Hosted by WPWL/103.7**

**Saturday, March 7, 2020**

**6-8 p.m. Pawling South Street Fire House**

1. Amateurs only, 21 years of age or older.
2. There are two categories: with meat and vegetarian.
3. You may enter more than one chili, up to three. Each is counted as an individual entry.
4. Your entry fee includes your admission.
5. Each entrant will be assigned a number which must be displayed on your table.
6. Tables and table clothes will be provided.
7. Tasting cups, spoons, and napkins will be provided.
8. You must bring your own serving utensils and provide your own extension cords.
9. Entrants should arrive by 5 p.m. to set up. Table decorations are optional.
10. Please bring at least one large crock pot of chili.
11. The name of your chili and a list of ingredients must be posted at your table. If your chili is hot/spicy, this must also be indicated.
12. If you are using any sensitive ingredients such as alcohol or nut-based oils, or other foods which may cause allergic or other reactions, you must post a sign on your table identifying this ingredient.
13. You may bring additional condiments if you want to enhance your chili.
14. Chili must be hot and ready to serve by 6 p.m.
15. Attendees will be admitted for tasting beginning at 6 p.m.
16. Chili should smell good, look good, and above all, taste good.
17. Judges will be seated in a separate, designated area.
18. Criteria for judging will be:
  - A. TASTE: Taste above all else is the important factor.
  - B. CONSISTENCY – Chili must have a good ratio between sauce and meat and/or beans.
  - C. AROMA – Chili should smell good.
19. All entrants are responsible for setting up their tables, and cleaning up at the end of the event.
20. All entry forms and fees must be received by March 1, 2020.
